



DO YOU TAKE THE TRAIN AFTER ARRIVING AT THE AIRPORT?



1) From Brussels International Airport (Zaventem) to Hansbeke:

The first option is to take a train from Brussels International Airport to Brussel-Noord (Bruxelles-Nord), then take a connection to Gent-Sint-Pieters. From Gent-Sint-Pieters take the train to Hansbeke. Take the stop train or L train direction Brugge or Zeebrugge (don't take the direct train!). Hansbeke is the 3rd stop (after Drongen and Landegem). The journey will take approximately 1,5 hours.

Alternatively you can take a train from the airport to Mechelen, then take the stop train or L train direction Brugge or Zeebrugge (don't take the direct train!). It takes you all the way to Hansbeke. The journey will take approximately 2 hours.

2) From Charleroi Airport (Brussels South) to Hansbeke:

Your preferred option is to take the <u>Flibco</u> <u>shuttle bus</u> servicing between Charleroi Airport (Brussels South) and the train station of Gent-Sint-Pieters (and Brugge) running 9 times a day. The bus stops near Gent-Sint-Pieters railway station. You can <u>book a seat on Flibco</u>. From Gent-Sint-Pieters take the train to Hansbeke. Take the stop train or L train direction Brugge or Zeebrugge (don't take the direct train!). Hansbeke is the 3rd stop (after Drongen and Landegem).

Alternatively, there are **regular bus connections** from Charleroi Airport (Brussels
South) to the train station of Brussel-Zuid
(Bruxelles-Midi). You will be able to **buy the bus ticket at the ticket office at the airport**.
From Brussel-Zuid (Bruxelles-Midi) take a train
to Gent-Sint-Pieters. From Gent-Sint-Pieters
take the train to Hansbeke. Take the stop train
or L train direction Brugge or Zeebrugge (don't
take the direct train!). Hansbeke is the 3rd stop
(after Drongen and Landegem).



For more information on schedules and tickets, check the website of the Belgian railways NMBS/SNCB. It might be useful as well to install their app on your smartphone during your stay in Belgium. You can download it for free from the App Store or Google Play Store.

It is possible to take a cab from the airport to Deinze (Nevele), but it is a very expensive solution: approximately 150 to 200 EUR.

The distance from Hansbeke train station to Mycelia is approximately 4 km, for which there is no public transport nor taxi service available. So, when you call the B&B owner 15 minutes before your arrival in Hansbeke, they will collect you at the train station.
